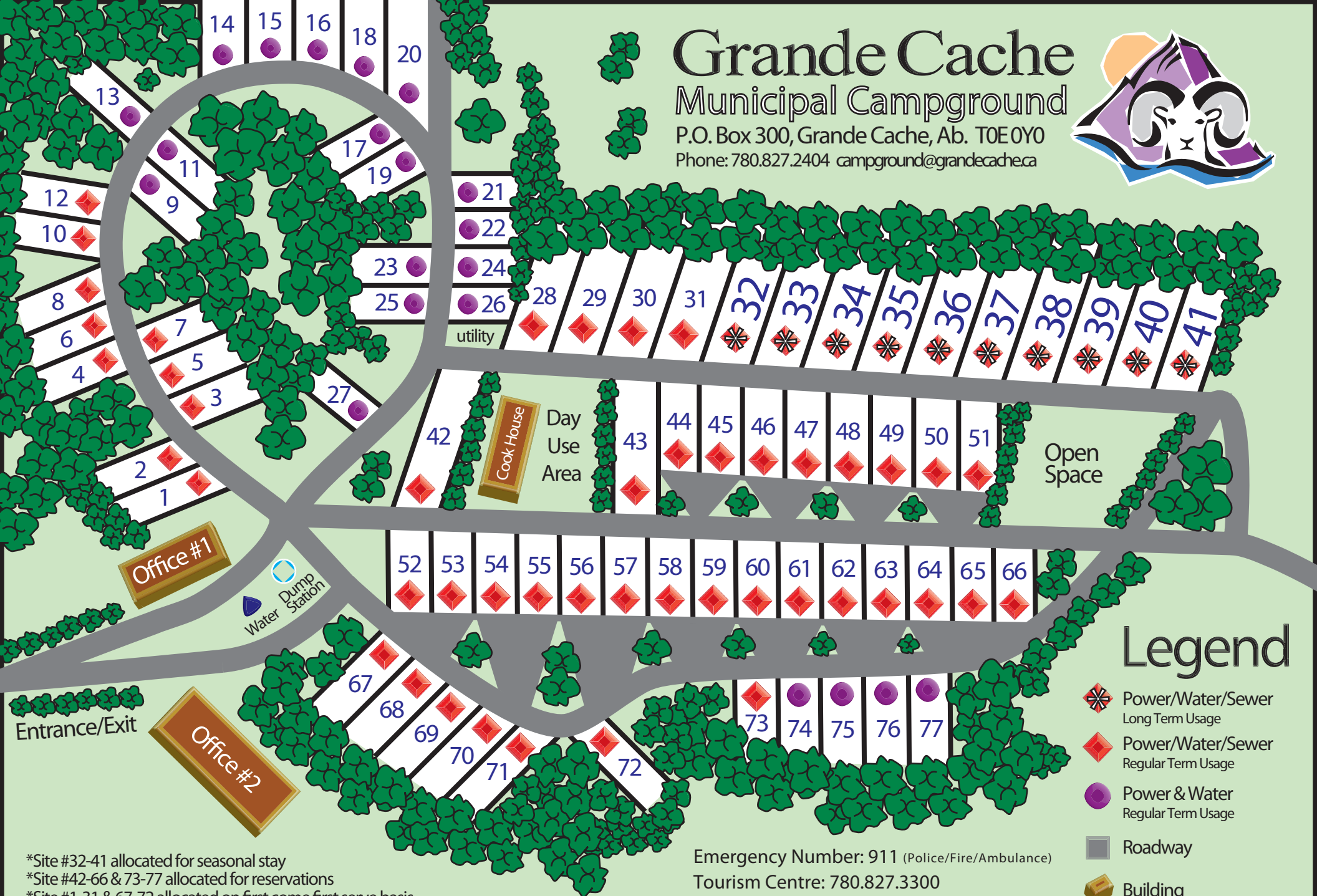

Grande Cache Municipal Campground: Information & Policies

Fee Structure:

Power/Water/Sewer: \$25.00
Power/Water: \$20.00

Payment of Camping Fees and Length of Stay Policy:

Check-out time: 12:00 p.m. (noon) Check-in time: 2:00 p.m.

All camping fees must be paid at the campground office. There are no refunds on camping fees. All campers must register prior to parking RV or setting up tent. Office hours are posted at the building. If you are checking out later than noon there is a \$10.00 late charge. Please check out at the campground office when you are vacating your site. Site checks are done daily by staff.

Camp Permit Policy

No one under 18 years of age will be granted a camping permit unless co-signed by a parent or guardian, who then assumes full responsibility for the campsite.

Number of Campers/Units

There is a limit of six people to a site, excluding families that exceed six people. Only one wheeled unit (trailers, tent trailers, RVs) and one additional tent are permitted per site.

Cleanliness

Please keep your campsite clean at all times. Remember to store all food in a safe place. Do not leave any food, empty cans/bottles, garbage, dog food, or bear attractants lying around. Remember to keep BBQs clean as well.

Quiet Time

Quiet time at the campground is 11:00 p.m. to 9:00 a.m. Noise will not be tolerated during this time.

Camp Fires

Please limit campfires to designated fire pits. No open or unattended fires. Firewood is free for campground use. Fireworks are not allowed in the campground for safety reasons.

Campground Policy on Dogs

Dogs are allowed but must be on a leash at all times. Please clean up after your pet.

Grey Water

Please, no grey water is to be drained into trees, work areas, or grass. There is a sewage dump located across from the campground office.

Shower, Washroom, and Laundry Facilities

The shower, washroom, and laundry facilities are located beside the main campground office. Shower and washroom facilities are free of charge. Washers and dryers are coin operated. Please help to keep these facilities clean for fellow campers.

Cook House and Day Use Area

There is a heated cook house and day use area located in the centre of the campground for all campground users. Please keep this area clean.

ATV Use

ATVs are not allowed in the campground.

Liquor

Alcoholic beverages are permitted only in registered campsites.

Damage Policy

Any damage to trees, sites, or any camp facilities will result in payment for the cost of clean-up, repairs, or replacement.

***Liability for loss or damage to personal property or personal injury while on campground property is solely the responsibility of occupant and guests.**

***Failure to observe the above rules may be grounds for eviction.**
