

# HWY 40 ACCESS MANAGEMENT STUDY – GRANDE CACHE PUBLIC OPEN HOUSE

## STUDY BACKGROUND

Future plans for Grande Cache requires examination of improvements to the existing Town road network. These improvements include an examination of the current condition of Highway 40 in terms of pedestrian and traffic movement, access management and overall safety.

MMM Group has been retained by Alberta Transportation to explore improvements which can be made to the Highway 40 corridor through Town.

- Develop preliminary improvement recommendations
- Present recommendations to Town council
- **Public Open House – Improvement Options**
- Finalize recommendations
- Complete report

## STUDY OBJECTIVES

This study will seek the following:

- To review and evaluate current and future access requirements from Hwy 40 to Grande Cache
- Ensure intersection locations and configurations are suitable to accommodate Town needs
- Identify potential safety issues for motorized and non-motorized traffic and recommend improvements

## TIMING

Study Completion: Spring 2009

Construction of the improvements will be dependent on a number of factors, including available funding and construction priorities.
